#### **Terms and Conditions of Authorisation**

1. The authorisation shall comply with the provisions of the Environment (Protection) Act, 1986 and the rules made there under.
2. The authorisation or its renewal shall be produced for inspection at the request of an officer authorised by the prescribed authority.
3. The person authorized shall not rent, lend, sell, transfer or otherwise transport the biomedical wastes without obtaining prior permission of the prescribed authority.
4. Any unauthorised change in personnel, equipment or working conditions as mentioned in the application by the person authorised shall constitute a breach of his authorisation.
5. It is the duty of the authorised person to take prior permission of the prescribed authority to close down the facility and such other terms and conditions may be stipulated by the prescribed authority.
6. The Unit will file the renewal application at least 2 months prior to the expiry of this Order

#### **Specific Conditions:**

1. The Bio Medical Waste generated by the HCF is 125 kg per day, unit shall segregate the waste as per the provisions of Bio-Medical Waste Rule, 2016 as amended and dispose the waste through CBWTF.
2. Unit shall properly operate and maintain the installed dedicated autoclave for treatment of discarded blood samples.
3. Unit shall maintain the records of Bio-Medical Waste generated, waste segregated and disposed.
4. Unit shall comply with the provisions of Bio- Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 as amended.
5. Generated Bio medical waste shall be collected, segregated and disposed according to Rule 4 and 8 of Bio-Medical Waste Management Rules, 2016 as amended.
6. The unit shall ensure safe disposal of Bio Medical Waste within 48 hours of generation and collection.
7. Solid waste generated shall be disposed according to Solid Waste Rules 2016 and shall not be mix with Bio Medical Waste.
8. Unit shall develop Green Belt in minimum 33 percent area of Industrial Premises as per the provisions laid down in office order no. H16405/220/2018/02 dated 16-02-2018 of U.P. Pollution Control Board. The copy of said office order is available on the website of U.P. Pollution Control Board [www.uppcb.com](http://www.uppcb.com).
9. Unit shall comply with the conditions imposed in the Consent to Operate issued under the provisions of Water (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1974 as Amended, and Air (Prevention and Control of Pollution) Act 1981 as Amended.
10. This authorization shall automatically become invalid on issuance of Closure Order by C.P.C.B / UPPCB and further on Revoking of Closure order, it shall become valid.
